THE PROBLEM IN GALATIA

I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to **live in the grace of Christ** and are turning to a **different gospel**—which is really no gospel at all. Galatians 1:6-7a

CHARACTERISTICS OF JOY-STEALING RELIGION: Evidently some people are throwing you into **confusion** and are trying to **pervert** the gospel of Christ. (v. 7) But even if we or **an angel from heaven** should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let them be under God's curse! As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted. let them be under God's curse! (v. 8.9) WHY FOCUS SO MUCH ON DOCTRINE? BECAUSE BAD DOCTRINE LEADS TO 3. _____ Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ. (v. 10) **KEY PHRASE:** "...live in the grace of Christ..." (Galatians 1:6a) **ASK YOURSELF:** AM I EXPERIENCING THE ______ THAT COMES FROM

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE: Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, who gave himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father. Galatians 1:3,4

DAILY MEDITATIONS

MONDAY Read Galatians 1:1-5. How does a true understanding of grace lead to peace? How does an incomplete understanding of grace take away peace? Are you experiencing the peace that flows out of an appreciation of God's grace in your life? Give God thanks for His grace toward you. Ask Him for the peace that comes from grace.

TUESDAY Read Galatians 1:6,7. The Galatians were receiving mixed messages about the gospel from these new teachers. Here are some you might still hear today:

COMMON MIXED MESSAGES ABOUT THE GOSPEL

God loves you unconditionally...
Jesus paid your debt in full...
God loves everyone equally...
Receive Christ to be saved...

Be sure you keep all the conditions!
Now stay "paid up" by doing good works
But some are loved more than others
Now don't sin or you may not be saved!

Which of these have you heard or believed? Why is it so easy to think like this? God calls us to "live in the grace of Christ". What do you think it means to "live" in grace? Thank God again for His grace. Ask Him to help you live in it!

WEDNESDAY Read Galatians 1:8,9. Why do you suppose that false teachers often claim extra revelation, often from an angel? It's fascinating to me that Paul would say, in effect, "If I ever teach weird doctrine, kick me out." In other words, he never says, "Accept my authority without question". How about you? Do you lead others in a way that stems from the gospel, or in a way that emphasizes your authority? Ask God to help you lead in a way that flows from your understanding of the gospel of grace.

THURSDAY Read Gal. 1:10. Apparently Paul had been a people-pleaser back in his legalistic days. How can you keep from being a performance-oriented people-pleaser and instead rest in God's grace and love? Today ask God for the wisdom to not be a people-pleaser!

FRIDAY In preparation for this weekend's message, read Galatians 1:11-24. What impresses you about these verses? Paul's transformed life caused people to praise God. In what ways could your testimony cause people to "praise God because of you"? How would you like to cause people to praise God? Thank God for your testimony—how he reached you when you were lost.

SATURDAY Please go over devotions you may have missed, and pray for this weekend's messages. Thanks!
