THREE STRATEGIES OF EVIL:

STRATEGY # 1: _____

The great dragon was thrown down--that ancient serpent who is called the devil and Satan the **deceiver** of the whole world Rev 12.9

And it **deceives** the inhabitants of the earth Rev 13-14b

DEFENSIVE MANEUVER:

ALWAYS ASK: _____ (See John 8:32; Ephesians 6:11-17)

STRATEGY # 2: _____

The people worshiped the dragon for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast saying, who is like the beast and who can fight against him? Rev. 13:4

DEFENSIVE MANEUVER:

REALIZE EVIL IS _____, BUT GOD IS _____

If anyone is to go into captivity, into captivity he will go. If anyone is to be killed with the sword, with the sword he will be killed. This is a call for patient endurance and faithfulness of the saints. Rev. 13:10

STRATEGY # 3:

Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say: "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Messiah. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down." Rev. 12:10

DEFENSIVE MANEUVER:

But they conquered him by the blood of the Lamb. Rev. 12:11

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE: Great and marvelous are your deeds, Lord God Almighty. Just and true are your ways, King of the ages. Rev. 15:3b

DAILY MEDITATIONS BRIEF DAILY DEVOTIONS RELATED TO TODAY'S TOPIC

MONDAY How have you seen the three strategies of evil in your own life? Which one seems to be happening in your life now? How can you defend against it? Ask God for the wisdom to defend against attacks of the evil one.

TUESDAY Read Revelation 12. This is a symbolic view of the history of salvation: The woman with 12 stars is Israel (the 12 tribes), and her child is Jesus. The dragon is Satan, and the various heads and crowns represent the human rulers who have been his agents on earth. They try to kill the Messiah, but he ascends to heaven. Satan realizes his time is short, and in fury tries to destroy the Jews, who are scattered among the nations. Then he makes war against her other "offspring", the Christians. After you read, pray for those under attack for their faith today, especially in the Middle East and Africa. Find out more at opendoorsusa.org/christian-persecution/

WEDNESDAY Read John 8:44. While some deny the existence of Satan and others are overly obsessed with the demonic, Jesus takes a third path: He acknowledges evil forces-and even Satan. But he calmly asserts victory over evil, as we can too. Be aware and prepared, but not obsessed. Here, the devil is described as a liar. He has no power to defeat God. Jesus says anyone who lies is modeling behavior of the devil! The best defense? Ask, "Is this true?" Ask God to help you remember that "the truth will set you free"!

THURSDAY Read Rev. 12:10. Satan is called "the accuser". He will accuse you of being unworthy of God's love, ungualified to do God's work, and unsure of God's salvation. Look at Ephesians 6:11-18. What six specific weapons does Paul instruct us to use against the devil's schemes? Notice that they all have something to do with the truth of the gospel: You are declared righteous in God's eyes, you are saved through faith and not works. How do these weapons work against the "accusations" of Satan? Pray through the Ephesians 6 passage asking God to fit you with these weapons today!

FRIDAY Read Rev. 13:4. Another strategy of Satan is intimidation. But the Book of Revelation was written to say, "Don't give up!" Rev. 13:10 counsels "patient endurance" and "faithfulness". One of the best strategies you can have against the evil one is to not quit! He will try to get you to feel overwhelmed and hopeless. Rev. 14:7 suggests one key to endurance: Fear and worship the true God, who made the world, and believe that His judgement will come. Where do you feel like quitting? Ask God for strength to overcome your discouragement!

SATURDAY Spend time in prayer thanking God for His gifts to you, including your salvation! Please pray for the weekend services, and for Easter coming up in just two weeks! Ask God to show you some people you could invite!
