Ask Him to bring godly friends along to help unbind you. Ask God to use you as an agent of freedom in your friends' lives.

Thursday

Read John 8:31, 15:15; 2 Corinthians 5:20a & 1 Peter 2:9. What are those who belong to God's kingdom called, according to these verses?
