MONDAY Read Acts 1:8. The believers in Acts were fueled by the power of the Holy Spirit—and so are you! We don't have to depend on our own cleverness or strength to get God's work done. We are conduits for a higher power! Ask God to help you truly believe in the power of the Holy Spirit!

TUESDAY Let's get our hearts ready for thanksgiving! Read Acts 16:26. Even in prison, at midnight, Paul and Silas could sing praises to God! What do you have to thank God for right now... that you would still be able to thank him for in the darkest of times? Praise Him today for His permanent blessings!

WEDNESDAY "...they shared everything they had..." (Acts 4:33) As you prepare for Thanksgiving, remember that the first Thanksgiving was as much an act of generosity as it was an act of gratitude; because of the generosity of the Native Americans, the settlers survived the harsh winter. So together, they gave thanks. Pray about ways you can show lavish generosity to others this Thanksgiving week!

THURSDAY Happy Thanksgiving! The word for "thanksgiving" appears in the Bible about 30 times (as translated in the NIV). One of the most famous: "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." (Phil. 4:6) Today, decide you won't be anxious about anything— at least for this day! Spend the day seeing things you're thankful for and whispering: "God, thank you!"

FRIDAY "I thank my God every time I remember you." (Phil. 1:3) Paul practiced a habit that modern experts say is key to growing the habit of gratitude: Using "gratitude" cues. Every time he thought of the Philippians, he thanked God for them. Can you develop similar habits? When you enter the grocery store, your workplace...etc, pray "God, thank you."

SATURDAY Please pray for the services this weekend, and come prepared to hear inspiring stories about Middle Eastern refugees we met on our trip to the Iraqi border last week!
