Linda Lawrence - will have spinal surgery at UCSF on 11/30. Pray for a successful surgery.

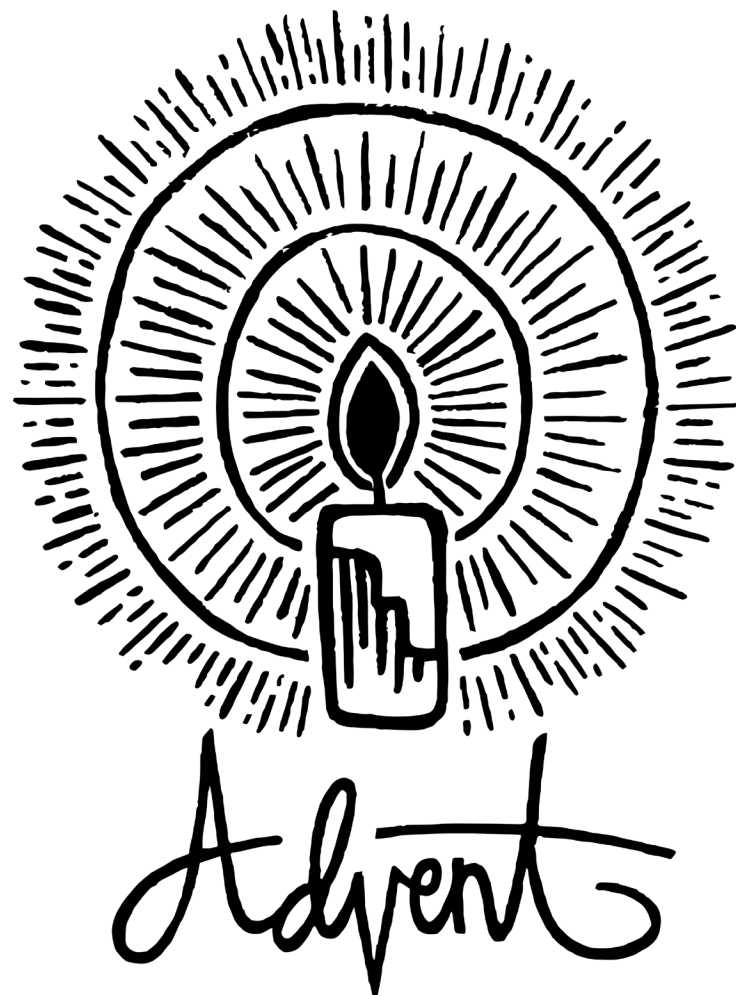
