GOD IS WITH YOU...

1. WHEN YOU _____.

The people of Israel mourned for Moses on the plains of Moab for thirty days... Deuteronomy 34:8a

“This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the LORD your God is **with you** wherever you go.” Joshua 1:9

Remind yourself: _____

2. WHEN YOU _____.

“When you see the Levitical priests carrying the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD your God, move out from your positions and follow them. **Since you have never traveled this way before, they will guide you.** Stay about a half mile behind them, keeping a clear distance between you and the Ark.” Joshua 3:3b-4a

“Look, the Ark of the Covenant, which belongs to the Lord of the whole earth, **will lead you** across the Jordan River!” Joshua 3:11

And the LORD said to Joshua, “Today I will begin to exalt you in the eyes of all Israel, **so they may know that I am with you** as I was with Moses.” Joshua 3:7 (NIV)

3. WHEN YOUR _____.

“Give this command to the priests who carry the Ark of the Covenant: ‘When you reach the banks of the Jordan River, take a few steps into the river and stop there.’” Joshua 3:8

It was the harvest season, and the Jordan was overflowing its banks... Joshua 3:15a

But as soon as the feet of the priests who were carrying the Ark touched the water at the river’s edge, the water above that point began backing up a great distance away... Joshua 3:15b-16a

Then Joshua said to the Israelites, “In the future your children will ask, ‘What do these stones mean?’ Then you can tell them, ‘This is where the Israelites crossed the Jordan on dry ground.’ For the LORD your God dried up the river right before your eyes, and he kept it dry until you were all across, just as he did at the Red Sea when he dried it up until we had all crossed over. Joshua 4:21-23 (See also: Joshua 4:1-9)

He did this so all the nations of the earth might know that the LORD’s hand is powerful, and so you might fear the LORD your God forever.” Joshua 4:24
