the Apostle Paul quickly summarizes his advice about how to live th	ıe
life God wants us to live:	

1. \_\_\_\_\_\_

As for other matters, brothers and sisters, we instructed you how to live in order to **please God**, as in fact you are living. Now we ask you and urge you in the Lord Jesus to do this more and more. For you know what instructions we gave you by the authority of the Lord Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 4:1,2

Our purpose is to **please God, not people**. He is the one who examines the motives of our hearts. 1 Thess. 2:4 NLT

Obviously, I'm not trying to be a people pleaser! No, I am trying to **please God**. If I were still trying to please people, I would not be Christ's servant. Galatians 1:10

It is a **dangerous trap** to be concerned with what others think of you, but if you trust the Lord, you are safe. Proverbs 29:25 TEV

(See John 12:43, John 5:41, Isaiah 51:12)

It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to **control your own body** in a way that is holy and honorable, not in passionate lust like the pagans, who do not know God; and that in this matter no one should wrong or take advantage of a brother or sister. The Lord will punish all those who commit such sins, as we told you and warned you before. For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life. Therefore, anyone who rejects this instruction does not reject a human being but God, the very God who gives you his Holy Spirit. 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8

3. \_\_\_\_\_\_

Now about your love for one another we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to **love each other**. And in fact, **you do love all of God's family** throughout Macedonia. Yet we urge you, brothers and sisters, to **do so more and more**. 1 Thessalonians 4:9-10

Let love be your highest goal! 1 Corinthians 14:1 NLT

...and make it your ambition to lead a quiet life: You should **mind your own business** and work with your hands, just as we told you... 1 Thessalonians 4:11

5.

...so that your daily life may **win the respect of outsiders** and so that you will not be dependent on anybody. 1 Thessalonians 4:12
