## Paul calls the Colossians back with a song in Colossians 1:15-23

He is the <b>image</b> of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. Colossians 1:15 NIV
2. Jesus is the
For by him <b>all things were created</b> : things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities all things were created by him and for him. Colossians 1:16
3. Jesus is the
He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. Colossians 1:17
4. Jesus is the
And he is <b>the head of the body, the church</b> ; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that <b>in everything he might have the supremacy</b> . Colossians 1:18
5. Jesus is the
For God was pleased to have all His fullness dwell in Him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by <b>making peace through his blood, shed on the cross</b> . Colossians 1:19,20

Once <b>you</b> were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled <b>you</b> by Christ's physical body through death to present <b>you</b> holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation— Colossians 1:21,22
