We ask that you do <u>NOT</u> check your child into a classroom when you have noticed one or more of the following:

- ❖ A runny nose of any kind.
- ❖ An undiagnosed skin rash.
 - Head lice
 - Persistent cough
- ❖ If a Child is too lethargic to participate in normal activities.
 - ❖ A fever of 100 degrees or above in past 24 hours
 - Sore of strep throat.
