- 1) How would you define Kindness?
- 2) Have you personally experienced acts of kindness that impacted your life in powerful ways? Share your stories with each other.
- 3) List some of the ways you have experienced the Lord's kindness in your life.
  - a) What effect does that have on your ability to show kindness to others?

- 4) What does kindness look like in practice? Is there any difference between kindness as a fruit of the spirit and just ordinary being nice?
- 5) What Bible passages encourage people to show kindness to one another?
- 6) Read 1 Cor 13:4 (NIV)

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.

- a) Can you be loving without being patient or kind? How are patience and kindness paramount to loving well?
- b) When is it most challenging for you to show kindness?
- 7) Read Psalm 136:1-9 (NIV) Remembering that "His faithful love endures forever" is translated from the word *hesed* which also could be translated "Loving Kindness".
  - a) What do you learn about God's character from these verses? How does this affect your relationship with him and others?
- 8) Read Micah 6:8 and Zechariah 7:9

He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to **love kindness (hesed**),[and to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8 (ESV)

"This is what the Lord Almighty said: 'Administer true justice; **show mercy (hesed)** and compassion to one another. Zechariah 7:9 (NIV)

a) According to these verses, how should we act as followers of Christ? Why is it important to administer justice and mercy/loving kindness together? How is God an example of this?

# **TAKE IT WITH YOU - 10 Minutes**

- 1) On page 93 in the book, Chris Wright says that kindness as a fruit of the Spirit does not come naturally but is a spiritual process that needs to be cultivated. It needs to become a habit in our life. What is one step you can take this week to cultivate the habit of kindness in your life?
